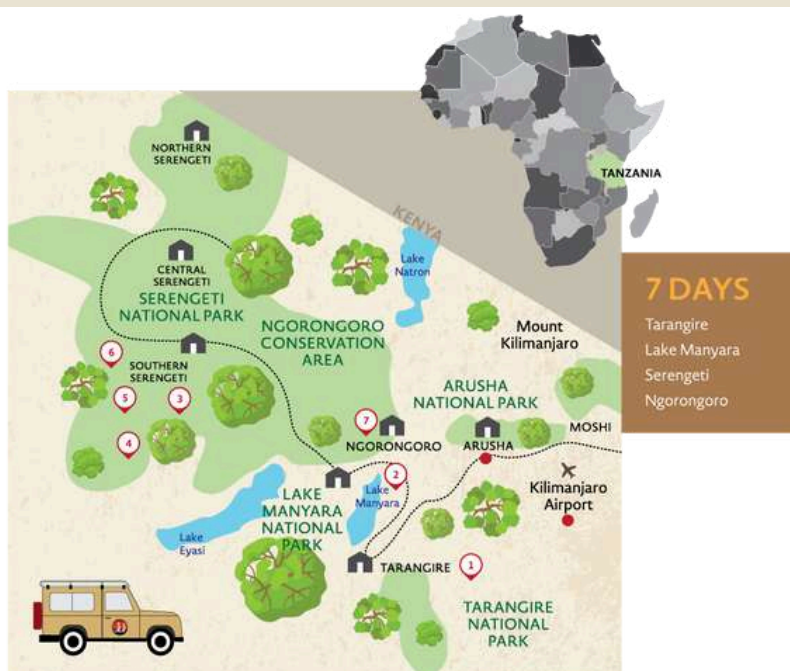


Trip Overview

Embark on a thrilling **7-day adventure camping safari** across Tanzania's most iconic wildlife destinations. Start in **Tarangire National Park**, known for its massive elephant herds and ancient baobab trees. Continue to **Lake Manyara National Park**, where tree-climbing lions and flocks of flamingos create unforgettable scenes against the backdrop of the Rift Valley.

Spend two full days exploring the vast **Serengeti National Park**, where you'll encounter the Big Five and, depending on the season, witness the awe-inspiring Great Migration. Conclude your journey with a visit to the world-renowned **Ngorongoro Conservation Area**, home to a rich array of wildlife, including rhinos, lions, and elephants. Each night, camp under the African sky, surrounded by the wilderness, making this a truly unforgettable adventure.



ARRIVAL DAY - Pick up from Airport

Greeted upon arrival at Kilimanjaro International Airport/Arusha Airport, followed by a transfer to your hotel in Arusha for an overnight stay

DAY 1 - Tarangire National Park

On the first day, you'll depart from Arusha after breakfast and head to **Tarangire National Park**, a scenic drive of about two hours. Upon arrival, you'll embark on an exciting game drive, exploring the park's vast landscapes filled with ancient baobab trees and spotting herds of elephants, zebras, and giraffes. Enjoy a picnic lunch amidst the wildlife before continuing your safari adventure in the afternoon. As the day comes to a close, you'll head to your campsite, where you'll relax and enjoy the sounds of the African bush under the stars.

DAY 2 - Lake Manyara National Park

After breakfast, depart for **Lake Manyara National Park**, a lush wildlife haven nestled at the base of the Great Rift Valley escarpment. Keep an eye out for the park's famous tree-climbing lions, playful baboons, and large herds of elephants. The lake itself is home to thousands of flamingos and other bird species, making it a birdwatcher's paradise. After a full day of exploration, head to your campsite for a night under the stars.

Important Notes

- It's essential to pack the **right clothing** for your safari. We recommend neutral colors like white, beige, and green. Be sure to bring a **warm sweater, socks, and a jacket**, as nighttime temperatures can drop to around 5°C
- **Luggage limit: 10kg per person.** Additional luggage can be stored in the hotel's storage room. Duffel bags are recommended
- Bring a towel
- **Towel** for shower and **toilet paper**
- **Mosquito repellent** with a high mint concentration
- **Binoculars** for enhanced viewing (guides will have one available to share in the vehicle)

DAY 3 - Lake Manyara to Serengeti National Park

On the third day, you'll journey from Lake Manyara to the **Serengeti National Park**, one of Africa's most famous wildlife reserves. As you traverse the vast plains, you'll witness incredible landscapes and diverse wildlife, including lions, elephants, and giraffes. After a hot picnic lunch, enjoy an exciting game drive through the Serengeti, where you may encounter the Big Five and other iconic animals. As the day winds down, you'll arrive at your campsite, surrounded by the sounds of nature, ready for a night under the African sky.

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DAY 4 & DAY 5 - Serengeti National Park

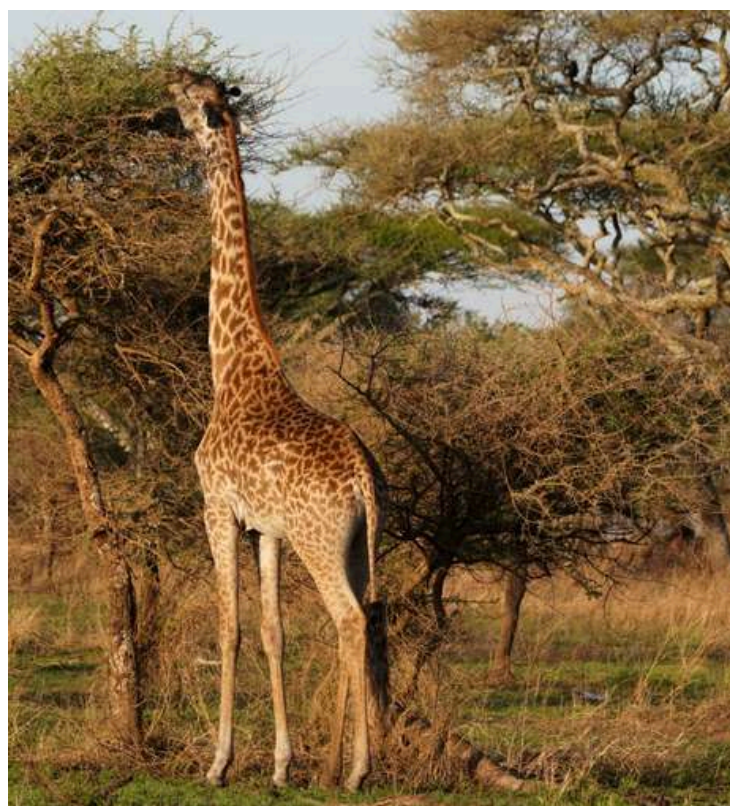

DAY 6 - Serengeti to Ngorongoro Area

Arrive at your campsite near the **Ngorongoro Crater** in the evening, ready to explore the stunning crater the next day. Camp overnight, surrounded by the beauty of this unique landscape.

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DAY 7 - Ngorongoro Conservation Area to Arusha
